Parish Jubilee of Hope Pilgrimage to St. Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh

Each parish has been invited to make a Jubilee of Hope pilgrimage to St. Patrick's Cathedral in Armagh in this Jubilee Year. Our parish will make our pilgrimage on Sunday August 31st. A bus will leave from St. Brigid's Church, Dunleer at 12.30pm and will arrive in Armagh for 2pm. We will begin our pilgrimage with refreshments (please bring a packed lunch).

A program of activities will begin at 2.30pm. This includes a guided Cathedral and museum tour, an opportunity to walk the outdoor 'Jubilee Walk of Hope' and a chance to spend time in prayer and reflection before joining together for Mass at 5.30pm in the Cathedral. After Mass, we will depart for home with dinner provided in The Armagh City Hotel.
