Beginning at 2.30pm, there will be a guided Cathedral and museum tour, an opportunity to walk the outdoor 'Jubilee Walk of Hope' and a chance to spend time in prayer and reflection before joining together for Mass at 5.30pm in the Cathedral. After Mass, we will depart for home with dinner provided in The Armagh City Hotel.
