Parish Jubilee of Hope Pilgrimage to St. Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh

Each parish has been invited to make a Jubilee of Hope pilgrimage to St. Patrick's Cathedral in Armagh in this Jubilee Year. Our parish will make our pilgrimage on <u>Sunday August 31st</u>. A bus will leave from St. Brigid's Church, Dunleer at 12.30pm and will arrive in Armagh for 2pm. We will begin our pilgrimage with refreshments (please bring a packed lunch).

A program of activities will begin at 2.30pm. This includes a guided Cathedral and museum tour, an opportunity to walk the outdoor 'Jubilee Walk of Hope' and a chance to spend time in prayer and reflection before joining together for Mass at 5.30pm in the Cathedral. After Mass, we will depart for home with dinner provided in The Armagh City Hotel.

Parish Consecration to the Sacred Heart: As part of our Jubilee of Hope, the parish will be consecrated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus on Saturday August 30th at 7.30pm Mass. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will be celebrated after Mass until 9pm.

St. Oliver Plunkett 400: Celebrating the 400th anniversary of Saint Oliver Plunkett's birth and the 50th anniversary of his canonisation, on **Sunday 27th July, a short walk will take place directly after 11:30am Mass**. The walk will proceed from St. Brigid's Church to the site of where St. Oliver Plunkett met with his priests of the surrounding area (currently the site of the Allcare Pharmacy). At the site, there will be a short talk followed by prayer.
