Plenary Indulgences in November: By long tradition, plenary indulgences for the souls of the departed may be gained in November as follows:

From 12 noon on 1 November until midnight on 2 November By visiting a church or oratory and there praying one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed, one Plenary Indulgence, applicable only to the Holy Souls, may be gained, by all those who:

- Have confessed (at any time within the week preceding or the week following 1st November)
- Received Holy Communion (any day from 1-8 Nov)
- Prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father, and Hail Mary or any other prayer of one's choice)

1st — 8th November

The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain one Plenary Indulgence, applicable only to the Holy Souls. The above conditions regarding Confession, Holy Communion and prayer for the Pope's intentions apply also for this.

Rosary in November: for the Holy Souls in Purgatory, the Rosary will be prayed in Dromin & Mosstown cemeteries on Saturdays in November at 3pm. The Rosary will also be prayed in St. Brigid's Church at 7pm each Monday in November. It continues to be prayed before each morning Mass Mon – Sat inclusive.
