Dromin 200: Further to it being a protected building, Louth County Council have approved a Section 57 Exemption requested by the parish for the painting of the interior of Dromin Church to proceed. More news and date of commencement shortly.

Credenda: The Things to Be Believed: A Course for Beginners in the Study of Theology, Begins September 2026. No previous knowledge of Theology required. No Exams. No Essays. Commitment is to: 1-hour personal study per week, and one 90min session with a Dominican Tutor. There are 24 sessions, from September to May, with 16 of these sessions on Zoom and eight in person. Subjects include The Existence of God. The Structure of Human Nature. Habit and Virtue. The Person of Jesus Christ. The Person of the Holy Spirit. The Sacraments. Personal Prayer. Witnessing to Christ. Cost is €190 and the parish will cover this cost for up to 5 parishioners who wish to complete this course. For more visit www.dominicans.ie/credenda.
