Credenda: The Things to Be Believed: A Course for Beginners in the Study of Theology, Begins September 2026. No previous knowledge of Theology required. No Exams. No Essays. Commitment is to: 1-hour personal study per week, and one 90min session with a Dominican Tutor. There are 24 sessions, from September to May, with 16 of these sessions on Zoom and eight in person. Subjects include The Existence of God. The Structure of Human Nature. Habit and Virtue. The Person of Jesus Christ. The Person of the Holy Spirit. The Sacraments. Personal Prayer.
