World Rosary Day: A Global Prayer for the Jubilee Year 2025

On October 7, 2024, Catholics around the world will come together for World Rosary Day. This special day of prayer has been initiated in response to Pope Francis' call for a "symphony of prayer" leading up to the Jubilee Year 2025. World Rosary Day will be marked by the recitation of the Rosary across the globe at 7pm local time, creating a continuous wave of prayer that will span from the East to the West. In a special way parents and grandparents are invited to use this special opportunity to share the gift and grace of the Rosary with children and young people.

To join with this global event of prayer, **the Rosary will be prayed in St. Brigid's Church on Monday October 7th at 7pm.** All are welcome. The weekly Rosary at the outdoor shrine will not take place that day and will resume the following Monday.
